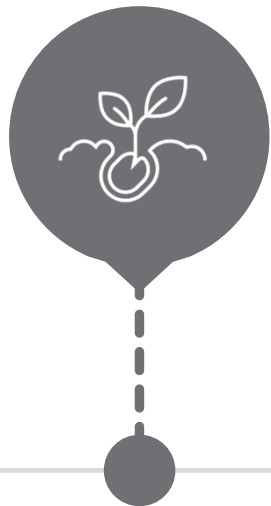

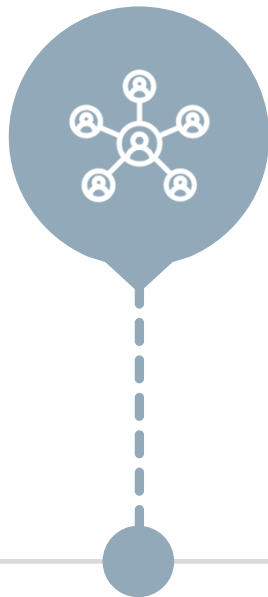

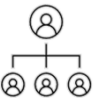
TPNM Structure 2021

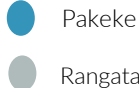

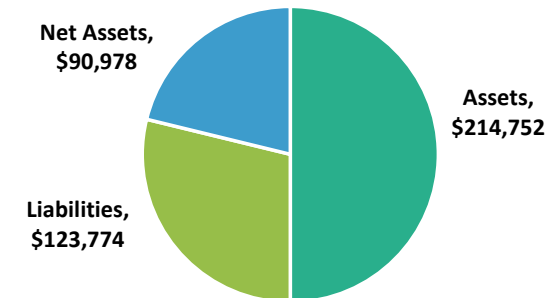

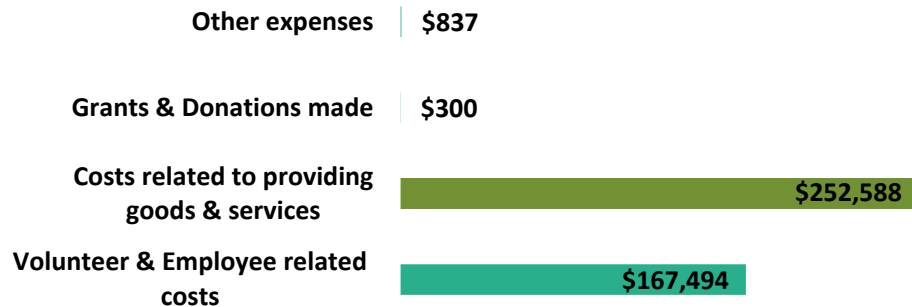
ANNUAL REVENUE BREAKDOWN



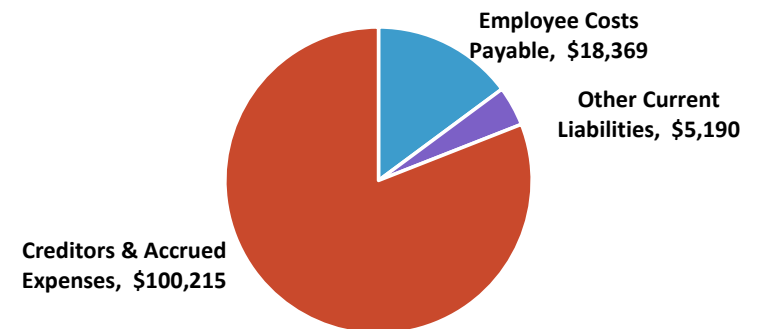
BALANCE SHEET SUMMARY
